Volunteer Registration

To those who would like to volunteer: There will be various times and days that I will need volunteers. The dates and times will be scheduled beginning the week of March 15th. If you have a specific day that you are available, please go ahead and specify when you sign up to be a seller. I will have a team that will be helping me with the volunteers. Each volunteer must sign an agreement form and sign their time in when they arrive and leave. You must see Angela or Allison to find out where you are needed. Please do not plan to shop during your volunteer time. You will have Monday to shop early. This is to ensure that everyone contributes their time fairly. You will need to contribute a minimum of 4 hours and this can be separated into 2 shifts. I will not be needing a large amount of volunteers during the day. We do need more in the evenings and on Wed. April 14th. We do need a large amount on the breakdown day. I will be making sure that the breakdown day is full before the schedule is complete. If you want to go ahead and volunteer for this day, please do so!! My dedicated committee has got to get tickets added up and we need the volunteers breaking down the racks. Please be understanding because it takes a lot to make this all run smoothly. I plan to keep Jack and Jill Kids very organized. Thanks to all of you for helping make this happen!

Jack and Jill Kids Spring/Summer Sale 2010

Hello, welcome to the third bi-annual Jack and Jill Kids Sale! I am as excited as I was a year ago. Our community has made this sale possible during these hard economic times. Please remember to spread the word to family, friends and coworkers. I will attach a full page flyer for you to copy and pass along to people in the community. If you as sellers help spread the word, then we will all receive positive results. The more people who know, the better your items will sell! Thanks

The consigners receive 70% of your total sales minus a \$6 dollar consigner fee. Each consigner must be very clear when pricing items. Only whole dollar amounts need to be placed on the items. Remember only very gently used clothes will be accepted. This is for everyone's benefit! When you are selecting your items, pick items people would want and be ready to buy. If your item has damage, stains or worn looking it will be placed to the side for you to pick up at the end if not seen at the check-in process. Please be understanding in this matter.

You must consign at least (30) acceptable items to be eligible for a pre-sale pass. The deadline for consigners to sign up is March 31^{st} .

There will be a maximum limit of 300 on the number of items brought to the sale. Please e-mail me with any questions about this.... Thanks

Items to bring:

Clothing:

Spring/Summer clothing only. Each item will be evaluated by the check-in committee! Please read the bullet points below to know what will and will not be accepted.

Shorts and capris ONLY (spring/summer type)

NO JEANS: Jean capris are ok...

Light weight jackets only. Ex. Rain or windbreakers

Shirts: NO worn t-shirts will be accepted and must look nice. Just ask yourself... Would I buy this? I will be very picky on these items. Short sleeve collar shirts are great!

NO GRAPHIC t-shirts.... Gap, old navy type are ok. Just no excessive wording or graphics.

If you bring any tank style tops, I will be very selective....pick your best only!!!

Some wind pants and light weight long sleeve collar shirts (All items that are questionable will be determined by the check-in committee. Please be understanding!

No stains, fading or excessive wear....

Remember that name brand clothes sell great!

Gap, Old Navy, Gymboree, Polo, Abercrombie, Aeropostle,
Nautica, Tommy, Kelly's Kids, Rags Land, Orient Expressed, Chez
Ami and Just Ducky etc...Smocking items also sell great.

**Remember that I will be very picky on t-shirts, shorts and all other clothing items. DO not bring it to the sale all wrinkled. I prefer things to be ironed, but if you cannot then use downy wrinkle release in the dryer. If they are too wrinkled, they may be rejected. Please understand I am keeping my sale NICE and this portrays a negative impression... Thanks a bunch!!

Maternity clothing will be accepted and please be sure to tag and hang as you will the children's clothing. I will accept

- longer pants for maternity but they cannot be winter like. No used nursing bras...
- Baby items-- Please pick your best items and remember if it cost \$5 at Walmart, then you cannot sell it for \$4 at the sale. Also, please limit the number of onesies. If we get a large excess, I will have to limit these items.
- Bathing suits will be accepted but must be like brand new!! No worn, faded or stretched suits will be accepted. They still need to be pinned on the hangers..
- No sleepers will be accepted in bags..... They should be hung like all the other items.
- No undergarments will be accepted unless they have been unopened.
- Socks, bibs, fancy pant bloomers must be almost new. These can be placed in a bag with the label attached.
- Monogrammed items: I will accept these with 3 initial, single initial and name. Please keep this to a minimum and remember to ask yourself.. Will this sell??
- Teen clothing will be accepted this sale. I know the sizes range but just use your best judgement. Clothes that would fit a 16 year old will be fine. I am keeping this to name brand clothing only.... Ex. Abercrombie, Aeropostle, Polo.... Or department store brands only.. Please pick your best on these as well! I did have a good response at the last sale on teen clothing.
- Prom dresses and pageant dresses: This will be new this spring but I thought it would be a nice addition. Dresses must be in EXCELLENT condition. If you have accessories to sell with it, please have it included in the price and attached to the bag with a separate tag with your seller number. Remember that all dresses need to have no stains, tears or lost beading. You can include the shoes but price them separate with your seller number included. I will have these shoes displayed by the dresses. All prom/pageant dresses must have your seller number on masking tape

inside the dress. This will help us if your seller number comes off.

Please remember that all items must be very gently worn!!

There will be no exceptions. Items that get missed at check in will get pulled and returned to you on Sunday. Also, please remember that all items must be SMOKE free. This is for all of our benefits. We want to buy neat and clean clothing.

How The Items Must Be Tagged

All tags must be printed on cardstock paper!! (You can purchase this for a few dollars at Walmart (scrapbook area). This helps with tags tearing so easily. Thank you

If you have a seller number from another sale and it has been approved, please read the following.

We will be very specific in how your tags are labeled for this sale. I am trying to make it easier if you do participate from another sale. On the other hand, I have to do what is best for Jack and Jill Kids Consignment. Only the ½ note card will be accepted from other sales. No barcode type will be accepted. If you have an original Jack and Jill Kids number, You MUST use my tagging method.

A yes or no must be written on the card for the ½ off day.. At the bottom of the card... If it says ND, it will still get sold at the ½ off sale. Please understand that I have to keep my sale organized and accepting other sale numbers can be confusing to the buyer and volunteers if they are not all the same.. If you have any questions on this, please e-mail me about it. Thanks for your understanding!

This is very IMPORTANT!!! If the items are not tagged correct, then there is a chance your item could get lost.....Also, if you would like to place a piece of masking tape by the tag with your seller number, you would have a better chance for not losing an item! Please be sure all tags are filled out. Item number is for your records.. Meaning item 1, 2, 3 etc. You do not have to do this if you prefer not too!

Each item that is clothing must be on a hanger..

The hanger should face you like a "?".

All buttons should be buttoned.. Zippers zipped up too....

All items must be ironed. They will sell better! Some items can be tumbled with downy wrinkle release.

Tags should be filled out clear and complete. Circle yes or no for the ½ off sale. If nothing is marked I will sell it at the ½ price on Saturday.

Remember pricing should not be too high but if it is new then sell it for at least half of the original price.

Only wire hangers will be accepted...You can get bulks of children hangers at the dollar store or walmart and target too. Please go ahead and start getting these NOW.. There are many sales going on and they will be gone! I will accept plastic but that is only if YOU CANNOT find the wire or wire coated. It looks nicer too having everything the same.

Items that need to be pinned must be pinned with safety pins only at the top of the hanger. (NO Straight Pins)....

Pin tags at top left corner of item as if you are wearing it... Absolutely (NO) straight pins!!!! Your items will be rejected. No straight pins anywhere!!!!

Shorts or acceptable pants (capris and wind pants) must be pinned at the top also.. Skirts too. All clothing must be pinned at the top of the hanger. If pinned at the bottom, they will not be accepted. They do not hang well or look good on the racks. Tops do not have to be pinned unless they have a

chance to fall off...

Outfits that go together should have set written on the tag and a separate tag with the seller number on the 2nd piece. Use a rubber band to tie the two together. Only one price on the front tag please....

Best way to make sure you pin the items correct..? Facing you, tag pinned at top left shoulder as you are wearing it..

Clothing must be sorted by sex, size, newborn, 3-6 mth, 12mth, 24 mth, 2t, 3t, etc. Just group them together with a rubber band or any way to place them together.

If you have any questions please feel free to e-mail me..This looks like a lot but it runs smoothly once you get to tagging.

Ex. --- how to tag the items....



Shoes:

Should not be scuffed or excessive wear. Please clean them as well. Try to pick your best.. Examples: sandals, church shoes--mary-janes, loafers, tennis shoes--be sure they are in excellent condition. No-- Walmart flip flops.... These are just a few examples. Remember that we will be very picky on athletic shoes with excessive stains or wear. Be sure to tag them so the tag will not get lost. If they are small shoes, place in a zip-loc bag and use clear packing tape to put the

price tags on. Shoes should be tied or in a bag with the tag attached.

Shoes must be tied together or in a zip-loc bag.. This is so your items do not get lost!!!

You will need to have them separated by BOY OR GIRL.

We will group the shoe sizes but be sure to label the exact size 11m or 11(1/2) or size 3-6mth etc. on the tag.. thank you..

No fall like shoes. (Rain boots will be accepted) No other boots will be accepted until the fall sale.

Other items suggested:

Hair bows or headbands.. Again place these in a zip-loc bag with the tag tapped on the outside. No hats please unless brand new..

Anything that you would buy at a consignment sale.. Keep this in mind when you are getting your items together.

Monogrammed hair bows or headbands.. Single initial or name on headband.

Toys, Baby items, Furniture, Dvds, etc...

These are great sellers!!

Strollers, car seats, pack and plays, swings, bouncy seats and high chairs and any other baby items... CLEAN GOOD.....

There will be a form to sign if you are selling a carseat. This is to release any liability on Jack and Jill Kids. The form will be signed by you, Jack and Jill Kids and the buyer. This is only to protect us all. Please do not try to sell any car seat that has been in an automobile accident or damaged in any aspect.

Baby furniture, dressers, changing tables, toddler beds, bedding sets, bassinets....

No used potty seats!

- All bolts, screws and any parts must be taped to the item in a zip-loc bag with your seller tag taped to it.... You do not want this to get lost....
- All items must be in working condition...meaning have batteries and all parts with it. We will check these items at check-in.
- Bedding sets need to be in a bag together and visible for the buyer. A large zip storage bag would be great.. No open bedding please.
- Remember there are always grandparents, aunts, child care givers needing extra items such as these...
- You can also take a picture of your bedding so the buyer can see it put together or give a good description on an index card next to the price tag.
- Stuffed animals must be collector type and very clean. I cannot take an abundance of this.

Toys, Dvd's, etc.

Please clean all toys good. Buyers do not want to buy something dirty.. Clorox wipes preferred!!

Again all parts must be with the items...

- Jack and Jill Kids will not be responsible for items brought that could get broken. Ex. Porcelain dolls, pictures, etc...
- Baby doll clothing- limited to American Girl type clothing only. Fold and place in large zip-loc bag. Can be sold with several outfits. Staple the bag or tape closed. Please tape the tag on the outside.
- They must be in working condition... Remember to keep this a great sale WE all have to work together on this..
- Only children or teen books will be accepted and these are subject to be rejected if they portray a bad image.

Dvd's must be in a case with a nice label on them. If you do not have the original case, it is ok just make a label for it. Make sure they are not scratched.

ANY games, game systems, --these are always good sellers, again make sure they are labeled and all parts together in a plastic bag. A large zip-loc or a clear storage bag. Please use the clear packing tape to tag the outside. If your game system is sold and does not work, you will be asked to not participate in Jack and Jill Kids sale again. I am very strict on this because we cannot try out the systems at check-in.

Baby toys, riding toys--bikes, power wheels, scooters---make sure they are in working condition. Include any rechargeable batteries please...

Kitchen sets and doll houses are good suggestions also...

Remember this is a good time to clean house but PLEASE do not bring junk to the sale. It will be rejected.. This is not a yard sale. It is a very clean consignment business!! Thank you in advance for remembering this.

Outside toys are accepted but please e-mail me to let me know so that I can guarantee that we will have adequate space for these items. Ex. Playhouses, sandboxes..

Pricing Instructions

Print or type neatly.. If the buyer cannot read it they may not buy it..

BE SURE your tag is filled out completely and your seller# and item# are on there.

Remember--- place a large piece of clear packing tape on large items and toys to ensure that it does not come off... You might want to do the masking tape on these items.

Briefly describe your item...ex. If there is a name brand put it

on the description.. Red (POLO) boys shirt.. A small description is good for you and the buyer. (in the space provided on the tag)

Also, please circle yes or no if you want your item to be sold 50% off on Saturday. This is totally up to you but please be sure to circle yes or no. If not marked, I will mark yes on the ½ day!!

Fill in all blanks on the price tag.

CONSIGNER # must be very clear.

Remember only whole dollar amounts...Nothing under \$1.00.. When you are pricing your items, try to remember about what you paid and if it still has the tags: 50% of what you paid. Or a little less. Try looking on e-bay as a guide...

You will get a consigner # when you sign up for the sale..
This will be your # for now and all future sales...

Also, if there is no price marked I will set a fair price for you!!

So please be sure you price each item.. Thanks

***Please remember that the check-in process will be the same as the fall. You will sign your information form and then be asked to wait 10 minutes or so until your items are checked in. No one will be allowed to go into the gymnasium to look around. Please understand that this is not the time to shop. Any rejected items will be sent with you that day. We are very busy putting all the items on the racks and tables. The only people allowed in this area are the ones scheduled to volunteer. Please understand that we do not want any hurt feelings and this makes it much easier for my check-in committee. My volunteers and sellers are amazing and I could not do it without each one of you! Thanks to you all for making this sale possible! I am looking forward to a GREAT sale!

Anyone who wishes to do so can donate items not sold to our

local charity. We will be donating to The Jones County Department of Family and Children Services. Also, depending on the amount left over we will give to a battered women's shelter in Central Georgia. You will let me know if you plan to donate left over items when you drop off your items.

Location: Jonesco Gymnasium (The Jones County Government Center in the heart of Gray) 166 Industrial Blvd. Gray, GA 31032

From Macon:

Take hwy 22 to Gray and go through town Before you get to the railroad tracks turn left onto Hwy. 11 Toward Monticello. Go through a 4 way stop and continue about a mile and the Government Center will be on your Rt. (go over the railroad tracks and merge left) Go around to the back and you will see the signs.

From Milledgeville:

Take Hwy. 22 toward Macon and go over the railroad tracks at the first light in Gray. Take a right onto Hwy. 11 and go through 4 way stop.. Go about 1 mile and the Government Center will be on your right.. Go around to the back (to the left) and you will see the signs..

There will be signs with arrows in town....

I WILL BE DOING A LOT OF ADVERTISING BUT THE MORE YOU TELL.. THE MORE WE WILL SELL TOGETHER...YOU CAN E-MAIL ME AND I WILL SEND YOU A FLYER TO COPY AND HAND OUT. I WILL BE PLACING THEM ALL AROUND CENTRAL GA.

Also, if you plan to shop at the sale be sure to bring a laundry basket or bag to put your items in...I will have a large amount there but bring one just in case....
